Required Elements for this Application:

- 1. Completed Application/essay
- 2. Copy of your most recent transcript (scan or take a picture)
- 3. Two letters of reference
 - One from a non-family member.
 - One from a high school teacher.

Applicants must fully complete this application and submit to ojslscholarship@gmail.com by March 1. The scholarship will be presented at Senior Awards Night.
